4	through his counsel, asked defense counsel Feb. 15, 2008 to withdraw Defendants' motion during		
5	the cooling off period, so that the parties could continue talks without the interruption of a motio		
6	for limited early discovery. Defense counsel did not respond. As settlement talks ended las		
7	Friday, defense counsel stated he would not withdraw the motion. Plaintiff is filing his motion for		
8	limited early discovery concurrently with this administrative motion, so that he may obtain th		
9	information necessary to oppose Defendants' motion to dismiss. He asks to stay briefing o		
10	Defendants' motion so that he may include information and argument based on the limited earl		
11	discovery in his opposition. Defendants oppose this administrative motion.		
12	If the Court decides not to grant this administrative motion, Plaintiff will file his oppositio		
13	by the current deadline, Feb. 29, 2008.		
14	II. Conclusion		
15	For the reasons stated above, Plaintiff respectfully asks the Court to stay briefing o		
16	Defendants' motion to dismiss for lack of subject matter jurisdiction.
