15	On October 15, 2008, Defendants filed an administrative motion to seal the Declaration		
16	of Matthew Katzer, submitted in support of its opposition to the motion for preliminary		
17	injunction. The matter is now ripe for consideration.		
18	Northern District Civil Local Rule 79-5 provides, in pertinent part:		
19	No document may be filed under seal, <i>i.e.</i> , closed to inspection by the public, except pursuant to a Court order that authorizes the		
20	sealing of a particular document, or portions thereof. A sealing order may issue only upon a request that establishes that the		
21	document, or portions thereof is privileged or protectable as a trade secret or otherwise entitled to protection under the law		
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24	N.D. Civ. L.R. 79-5(a) (emphasis added).		

Defendants seek to have the Katzer declaration sealed in its entirety. Based upon the Court's review of this declaration, it is clear that at least some of the paragraphs contain information that, on its face, does not appear to be confidential. See, e.g., Katzer Decl. ¶¶ 1-2, 7.

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Accordingly, the Court DENIES WITHOUT PREJUDICE Defendants' motion to seal
This ruling is without prejudice to Defendants submitting a renewed motion specifically
identifying those paragraphs that contain confidential information and to filing in the public
record a redacted version of the declaration, omitting only that material which is confidential.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
